

2ND QUARTER KINGDOM OF ATENVELDT YOUTH MINISTRY REPORT

April - June 2003

OVERVIEW OF ACTIVITIES

APRIL:

A one-year Warrant Renewal for Lady Sorcha as the Kingdom Minister of Youth and a deputy warrant for Lady Jehanne was obtained.

Contact was made to with Duchess Lyn, Autocrat for the Spring 2003 Coronation, to discuss arrangements in providing children's activities at the event.

The Kingdom Youth Ministry proposed several ideas for a heraldic badge to represent the office in Atenveldt. An Easter Egg Hunt was held for children in the Baronies of Atenveldt and Twin Moons. Approximately 24 prizes from the Youth Ministry Inventory of youth store items were also distributed.

The incoming Youth Minister for the Barony of Twin Moons, M'lady Elizabeth, was welcomed and provided with supplies from the Youth Ministry Inventory. We offered a fond farewell to our friend and colleague Lady Kathyne Gordon who left the Youth Ministry office in Tir Ysgithr to follow her husband to Korea with the military.

Lady Jehanne drafted and submitted an article from the Kingdom Youth Ministry for publication in the June 2003 Southwind. As the Autocrat of the Kingdom Youth Collegium, Lady Jehanne prepared and submitted an event article for submission in the Southwind. She also collaborated with many gentles in preparation for the event.

MAY:

The outgoing Society Children's Officer Coordinator, Countess Anora, was tearfully thanked for her hard work, just as we welcomed the incoming officer, THL Yseult to the position. We look forward to further collaboration and participation with our counterparts across the known world.

Following the announcement that the Kingdom Youth Collegium would not be rolled over to the next year. Multiple brainstorming ideas were generated on the Aten Youth List regarding a possible youth/family oriented event to be conducted in the 2004 calendar year. Lady Sorcha was present at the Kingdom Calendar Meeting at Coronation and the Kingdom Officer Meeting at the Sun Dragon Baronial A&S Champion event.

The Kingdom Youth Ministry conducted limited children's activities for interested youth at the Kingdom Champions Tournament. Approximately 15 young persons attended and participated. Supplies for the activities were provided from the Youth Ministry inventory.

Contact was made with M'lady Alana de Featherstonehaugh who responded to the Southwind article regarding the need for a replacement for the Kingdom Youth Minister in 2004. We will be fostering a relationship with this interested gentle in the months ahead, so that a smooth transition can occur if she is selected as Lady Sorcha's successor.

At the request of the Autocrat, tentative facility arrangements were outlined regarding the Kingdom Youth Ministry providing youth activities at the Fall Crown Tournament. Lady Jehanne prepared for children's activities to be offered throughout the weekend of the Kingdom A&S Collegium.

The Youth Ministry welcomed M'lord Cainneth MacFie as the newest Youth Minister for the Barony of Mons Tonitrus.

General administrative assistance was provided to our counterpart in the Kingdom of Atlantia.

Lady Jehanne drafted and submitted an article from the Kingdom Youth Ministry for publication in the July 2003 Southwind. Planning for the Kingdom Youth Collegium continued.

Moderated discussion and dialogue on the Aten Youth List. Participated in discussions on Society MOC List.

JUNE:

Lady Jehanne provided children’s activities throughout the weekend of the Kingdom A&S Collegium.

Plans were discussed to host a Known World Youth Conference in the Kingdom of Artemisia, to coincide with their new war being planned for July 2004.

Lady Jehanne drafted and submitted an article from the Kingdom Youth Ministry for publication in the July 2003 Southwind. She also completed the required monthly report form as the Estrella War XX Children’s Steward.

Moderated discussion and dialogue on the Aten Youth List. Participated in discussions on Society MOC List.

NEXT QUARTER ACTIVITIES

We plan to attend and participate at the Kingdom Youth Collegium, Highlands War, Kingdom A&S Competition, and Crown Tourney in the months ahead.
