

Kingdom Signet's List of Scrolls to go out Periodically

Crown Tournaments (every 6 months):

Warlord	King only signs
Queen's Rapier Champion	Crown Princess only signs (Princepessa Atenveldtus)
Shield of Chivalry	Queen only signs
Hand Bow Archery Champion	King & Queen sign
Crossbow Archery Champion	King & Queen sign
Youth Archery Champion	King & Queen sign

Stepping Down, Coronation & Champion Tournaments (every 6 months):

Stepping Down:

Lion	King only signs
Commander of the Light of Atenveldt	King & Queen sign
Commander of the Azure Archers	King & Queen sign
Commander of the Fleur de Soleil	King & Queen sign
Commander of the Hawk's Lure	King & Queen sign
Commander of the Pilgrim of the Desert	King & Queen sign
Commander of the Queen's Grace	King & Queen sign
Commander of the Queen's Cypher	King & Queen sign
King's Sigils	King only signs
Queen's Cyphers	Queen only signs
White Oak (Retiring Bard of the Sun)	King & Queen sign

Coronation:

County(s) or Dutchy(s)	King & Queen sign

Champion Tournaments:

King's Champion	King only signs
Queen's Champion	Queen only signs
Youth Defender	King & Queen sign
Youth Warlord	King & Queen sign

Baronial Investitures (every 2-3 years per Barony):

Thegn (male) & Bannthegn (female) King & Queen sign

Investiture Scrolls King & Queen sign

- These are given by the tradition of the Barony and the will of each Crown. (Ask the Crown first if they are O.K. giving them, then the incoming B&B if they want one if the Crown says it's O.K. with them.)
- They are taken out of the Baronial Scribe's stock of paper.
- They are traditional for the Baronies of Tir Ysgithr and Twin Moons.

Special Notes:

Royal Menagerie scrolls are supposed to be signed by the Queen only, but many King's want to sign them as well.

It is best to give the scribe **2 months of lead** time to do personalized scrolls; any less than that and they are rushed, any more and they loose interest in the project.

Due dates for scrolls need to be set at least 1 week before an event so that pictures or scan of the outgoing scrolls can be taken before they actually go out.
