WHAT EVERY FIGHTER WANTS YOU TO KNOW

THE FIGHTERS BILL OF RIGHTS

If I refuse care and I am oriented and coherent (Even if annoyed, preoccupied or angry) that is my legal right.

It is up to me whether or not I go back to fighting. I am an adult with a signed waiver. If you feel I am a danger to other fighters or myself, tell a marshal of your concerns. But, do so quietly please, so that if either of us is wrong, neither of us will be embarrassed.

If I am injured, ask questions and listen to me and my friends and family. Like me, they also know what is normal for me and how my armor goes on and comes off. Before you do anything, from slapping a cool cloth on my neck to cutting my armor, ASK ME. Maybe I'll like it, maybe I'll club you like a baby harp seal.

REASONS A FIGHTER MIGHT REFUSE CARE

- ☞ He/She is fine or will be in a minute.
- ☞ He/She has a personal friend that takes care of his/her personal injuries.
- ☞ He/She is fine or will be in a minute.
- ☞ YOU are too intense.
- ☞ He/She is fine or will be in a minute.
- ☞ He/She is a First-Aider, EMT, Nurse, Paramedic, MD and will take care of it themselves.
- ☞ He/She is fine or will be in a minute.
- ☞ They don't know who or where they are (this is extremely rare).
- ☞ He/She is fine or will be in a minute.
- ☞ It's the same old knee, elbow, shoulder... and they will take care of it the same way as the last fifty times.
- ☞ He/She is fine or will be in a minute.

MORE PRACTICAL MATTERS

A thousand years later, armor still makes a great splint. Move any injured fighter that can be safely moved. With Suspected major injuries, tensions increase. Be aware of the tension level. You control the tension level. If you are calm, so are the people involved. If you behave agitated, or panicky, you increase the fear and apprehension of everyone involved. Humor can be a valuable tool. It's important to take peoples fears seriously, but not to feed their panic. Address them and surrounding people in a calm manner, keep your voice low. Address your questions to the injured person.

Atenveldt Baronial Yule



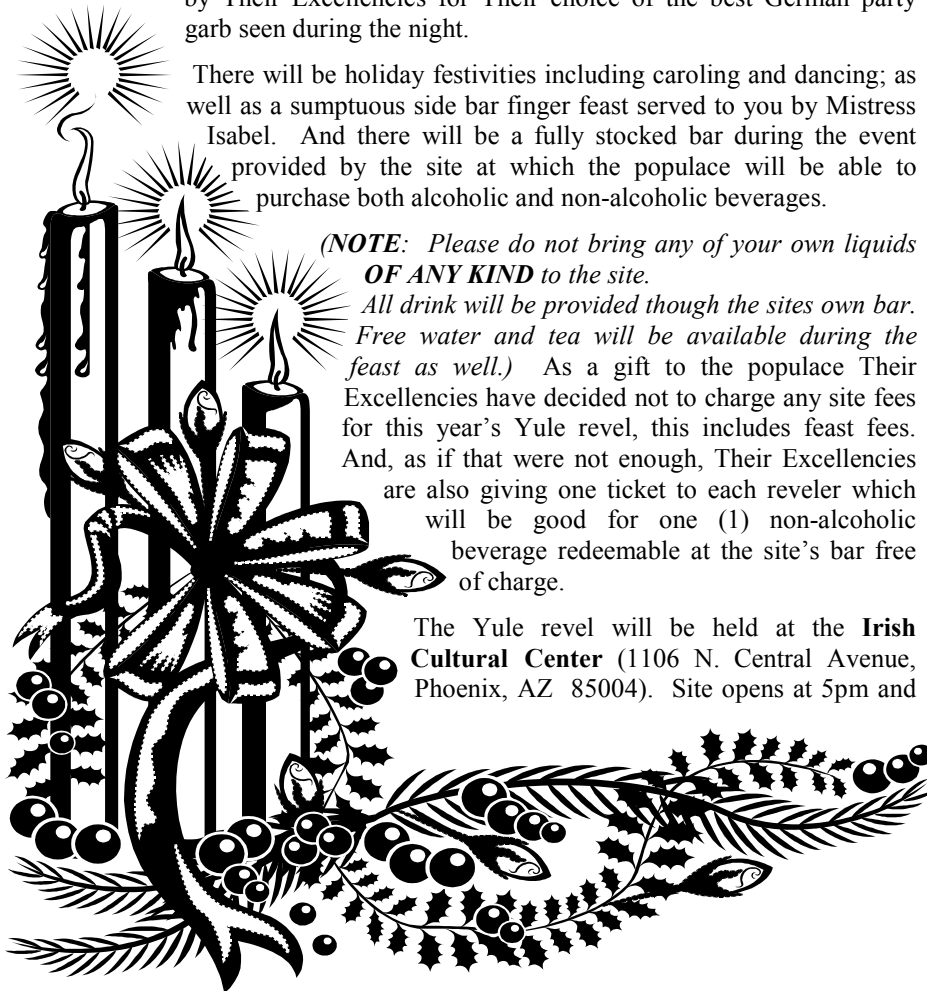

Never fear if you don't have a favorite machine we can help you find one! Bring your donations early to the registration table and choose your machine.

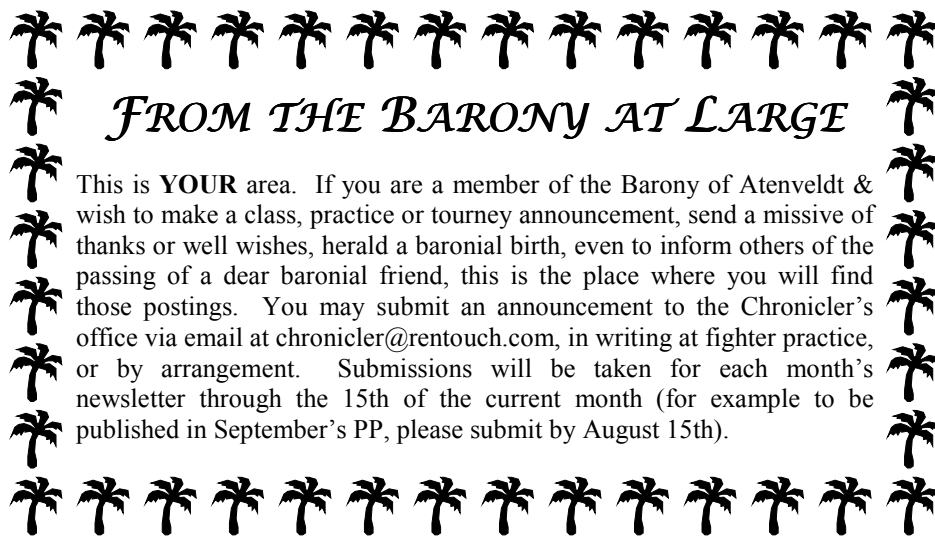

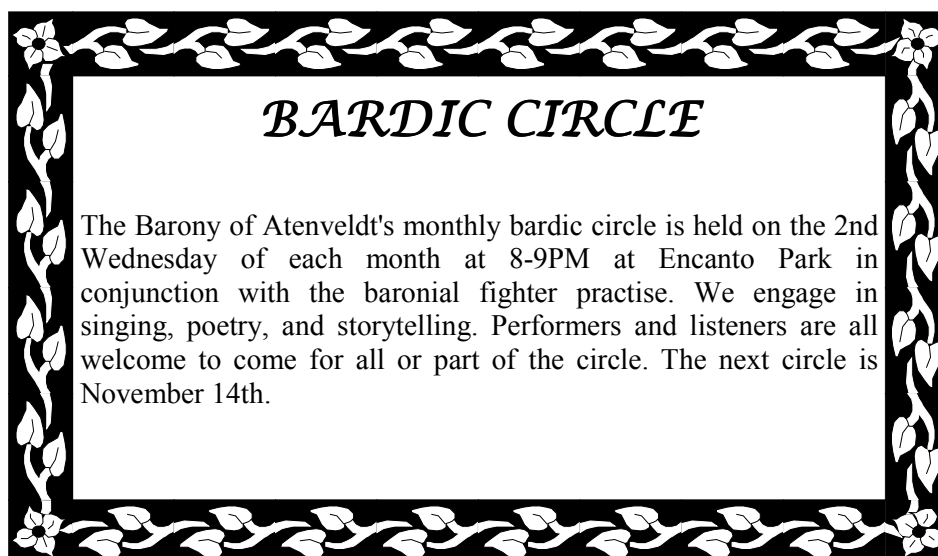

## *Sheriff* (Open until January 15, 2008)

The Office of Minister of Arts and Sciences is responsible for fostering the study of period culture and technology, and methods for producing historically accurate artifacts and performances. His/her duties include promoting the dissemination of accurate information about the fields under study. It is also the responsibility of the Minister of Arts and Sciences to help organize demonstrations, exhibitions, competitions, classes, workshops or deputies can do this. By all means do not feel you have to take on this job without help.

Every local A & S Officer must submit monthly reports summarizing the activities of the local group and local members. Being accessible to the Barony and keeping the populace educated about what is happening both locally and at the Kingdom level is a vital part of the job. Another important part of an A & S Officers' duty is communication with artisans so that each gets the help and recognition that is needed. The A & S Officer is responsible for promoting all aspects of the Arts and Sciences including period-inspired creativity, scholarly research or authentic research. Anyone who shows an interest in the arts and sciences should be encouraged thorough competitions, displays, teaching or performing, to name a few. The A & S Officer should also help at Kingdom A & S events and Collegiums whenever possible and actively recruit participants and teachers.

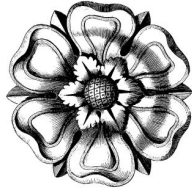

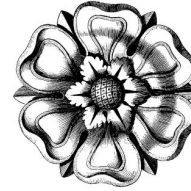
ARTS & SCIENCES At Estrella War XXIV!!

Volunteering at Estrella War XXIV Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

Last revised September 23, 2007

Can I take my child with me on my volunteer shift?

Yes and No. Many factors determine whether this is possible, including the age of the child, the duties assigned, the time of day you volunteer, and more. It is best to contact the person coordinating the department where you wish to volunteer in advance and consult with them. This can be done by email before the event (see the STAFF list page of the website for contact information), or you can take your question to Volunteer Point after you arrive at the event.

Can my youth (9 to 17 years of age) volunteer, and if so where?

This depends on a number of things, and the policy may change before war. At the time of this writing (September, 2007), youth volunteers are welcome to assist in some areas, with the understanding that there are restrictions on both the age for some duties, and the actual tasks youth volunteers may be assigned. It is best to contact the department you wish to volunteer for in advance and consult with them. As a general rule, youth can volunteer if they work along with their parent /legal guardian. Unaccompanied youth may not work in an enclosed tent (defined as having sides and door) unless accompanied by at least two unrelated adults and/or have their parent/guardian present.

I understand that I get to designate the name of an official SCA group (Kingdom, Barony, Shire, Canton, etc.) to receive credit (volunteer dollars) for the volunteer hours I work at the event. Can I split my hours between two different groups?

Yes, you can. You can sign in twice at the place you work, and indicate the portion of your hours to credit to each group. You will be asked to record your hours and designate the group to receive credit at the location where you volunteered. At the same time, you will also be offered a Volunteer Raffle Voucher to take to Volunteer Point if you wish to participate in the Volunteer Raffle.

Can I credit my hours to my Household, so they receive the volunteer dollars?

No. Only official SCA groups (Kingdom, Barony, Shire, Canton, etc.) may be designated to receive volunteer dollars for your work.

Can I give my Volunteer Raffle Voucher for the raffle to someone else?

Yes. You may give your voucher to anyone you choose (perhaps that kind person who made your breakfast). Just remember that the Volunteer Raffle Voucher must be taken to Volunteer Point to participate in the raffle.

Everyone attending Estrella War XXIV is encouraged to volunteer (and everyone's help is needed!). 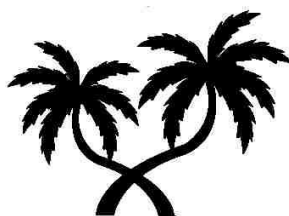
