Polling Information



A polling of the current paid members of the Barony of Atenveldt will be conducted on Saturday, September 21st 2024 to determine their support of candidates for Baron & Baroness. A virtual poll will take place exactly one week prior to the in person polling. The virtual poll will close as the in-person polling begins.

The populace should be aware that if the first polling does not show a clear preference of the populace, a second polling may be held immediately following the closing tabulation of ballots for the first poll. Members are encouraged to plan to remain onsite to participate should a second poll be necessary.

To participate in all pollings held that day, you must be a Sustaining, Associate, or Family member who is 18 years old or older, and must receive a Southwind or have an SCA membership in a Zip Code belonging to the Barony of Atenveldt.

r. Current paid memberships will be verified on a membership list at the polling site, or you may present an online membership renewal dated after the date the membership list was generated by the Milpitas Registry. The Kingdom Seneschal recommends you bring proof of membership with you to ensure participation in the poll.

2. You must reside in zip codes belonging to the Barony of Atenveldt, this will be verified on the membership list at the polling site.

3. NOTE: Paid members who play in the Barony of Atenveldt, but do not reside in the zip codes belonging to the Barony, may not cast ballots. However, they are encouraged to make their views on candidates known to the Crown by sending personal letters to the Crown & Kingdom Seneschal expressing their candidate selections & Crown will consider such letters when reviewing the polling results.

4. You must be 18 years old or older; present a picture ID at the polling site that shows your date of birth or age.

**** SPECIAL ZIP CODE EXCEPTION ****

If you DO NOT HAVE a membership address in a zip code assigned to the Barony of Atenveldt, but your membership is current and in a zip code in metropolitan Phoenix, you will be asked to sign a Pledge Form before you can receive a ballot. The Pledge Form shows your agreement with this statement:

"I consider myself a member of the populace of the Barony of Barony of Atenveldt, and promise the Crown of Atenveldt that I will not cast a ballot in any Pollings held in the Barony of Sun Dragon or the Barony of Twin Moons for 3 years following the date of this polling."

A list of the members who sign this Pledge Form will be kept by the Kingdom Seneschal's office, and by the Seneschals of the three Baronies in the Phoenix metropolitan area. After signing the Pledge Form, you will be given a different color ballot to indicate your preference for Baron and Baroness.

Baronial Chatelaine

Job Description: We are seeking a communicative, kind person to serve as our Baronial Chatelaine. Baronial Arts and Sciences Minister

Job Description: We are seeking a passionate and dedicated individual to serve as our Baronial Arts and Sciences Minister. In this role, you will be responsible for overseeing and promoting the arts and sciences activities within our barony, and fostering a culture of learning, creativity, and camaraderie. This is a vital position that contributes to the enrichment of our SCA community.

Responsibilities:

- Organize and promote arts and sciences events, workshops, and competitions.
- Encourage members to explore and develop their artistic and scientific interests.
- Mentor and support individuals in their pursuit of period-appropriate crafts and skills.
- Collaborate with other officers to coordinate and enhance baronial events and activities.
- Maintain records of arts and sciences activities within the barony.
- Serve as a liaison between our barony and the Kingdom Arts and Sciences community.

Qualifications:

- Enthusiastic about medieval and Renaissance arts and sciences.
- Excellent organizational and communication skills.
- Ability to work collaboratively and motivate others.
- Familiarity with SCA culture and customs is a plus, but not required



Baronial Youth Officer

Job Description: The Baronial Youth Officer is a crucial role responsible for creating a safe, fun, and educational environment for the young members of our barony. This position provides an opportunity to inspire and educate the next generation of SCA enthusiasts.

Responsibilities:

- Organize and oversee youth-specific activities at baronial events.

- Prior experience with youth programs or teaching is a plus but not required.



Baronial Regalia Officer

Job Description: The Baronial Regalia Officer is a pivotal role responsible for the management, maintenance, and enhancement of our barony's regalia and ceremonial equipment. This role offers a unique opportunity to contribute to the visual and ceremonial identity of our barony.

Responsibilities:

- Maintain an inventory of all baronial regalia, banners, and ceremonial items.
- Oversee the storage, transportation, and display of regalia at events.
- Collaborate with artisans and volunteers to create new regalia and accessories.
- Ensure that regalia is maintained in good condition and repaired as needed.

This position offers a unique opportunity for rapier enthusiasts to share their passion and expertise.

Responsibilities:

- Assist in the planning and execution of rapier combat events, practices, and tournaments.
- Promote and enforce safety protocols to ensure all rapier activities comply with SCA regulations.
- Organize and participate in rapier classes and workshops to educate and train new fencers.
- Collaborate with the Baronial Rapier Marshal and other officers to enhance the overall rapier combat experience.
- Maintain rapier equipment and assist in equipment inspections.

Qualifications:

Baronial Social Media Officer

Responsibilities:

- Maintain and update the barony's social media accounts with current information about events, activities, and announcements.
- Create and share engaging content that promotes the barony and encourages participation.
- Monitor social media interactions, respond to inquiries, and moderate discussions to ensure a positive and respectful environment.
- Collaborate with other officers and event organizers to gather content and promote activities.

Qualifications:

- Proficiency in using social media platforms (Facebook and Instagram required, others to be considered).
- Familiarity with SCA policies and guidelines regarding online conduct and content.
- Ability to create engaging and informative content and communicate effectively.
- Organizational skills to manage multiple social media accounts and schedules.



Baronial Sheriff

Job Description: The Sheriff is responsible attending baronial events to ensure the physical security of persons and items. The Sheriff is in charge of the Lost and Found and watch during events.

Responsibilities:

- Coordinate with event organizers and other officers to address any safety concerns or issues that arise.
- Work in conjunction with the Baronial Seneschal to address any safety concerns or issues at events.
- Coordinate Watch shifts for Baronial events and at Kingdom events when necessary.

Qualifications:

- Knowledge of SCA rules, policies, and safety guidelines.
- Demonstrate honesty and integrity in all situations.
- Ability to handle conflict and enforce rules in a fair and respectful manner.
- Good communication and coordination skills.


Fighters: Start arriving early to get armored up, lights will come on at 8, and we will start practice as close to that time as possible.
