Greetings all!

I've been informed that some people are unclear as to the kingdom policies relating to monies for submissions. This email is to clarify things, and avoid misunderstandings.

To make sure that we are all on the same page, here is the kingdom policy:

Only persons with an exchequer's warrant are allowed to take monies for submissions. The proper process for people to pay for their submissions is to use the form in this link:

To pay for heraldic submissions, you have 2 options:

- 1) Mail a cashiers check or money order made out to **SCA, INC.**
- 2) Pay online via a PayPal invoice

The above form should be used no matter which method you choose to use. Under no circumstances should you accept cash or a personal check.

Weighted Tablet Weaving: My Warping Process

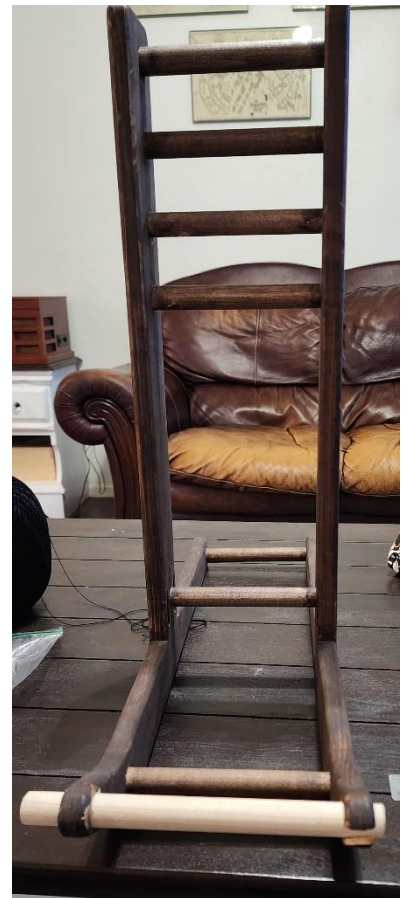

I was asked by Her Excellency to do a tutorial on how I do card weaving. I decided to just show my tools and the warping process. The whole process of weaving is a lot of information and is better to teach in a hands-on setting. So, if you are intrigued and want a hands-on class let me know and I can set one up.

First off, we need to start with the tools you need.

First and foremost, you need some type of a loom. This is the one [on the right] I like to use but any loom can work.

Then you'll need a few other tools pictured below.



These are the tools I like to use. I started off with just the hex nuts and rubber bands but have added the bobbins and love using them. They are not a must in order to get started. These are things that I've found help me be more efficient while weaving. I use the binder clips if the bobbins are too full and won't stay up.

Next, you'll want to pick a pattern. I highly recommend for your first few patterns that you pick ones that are easy. This pattern will first be used to warp the string.

The pattern below lists out how the warp will be loaded on each card.

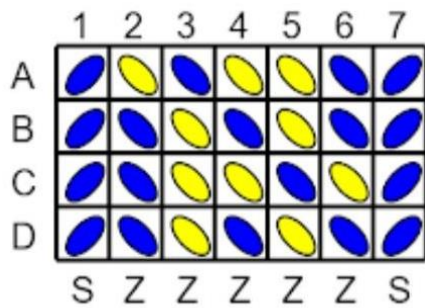
The numbers on the top are the card number, and the letters represent what hole in the card.

This pattern shows card 1 has 4 blue strings

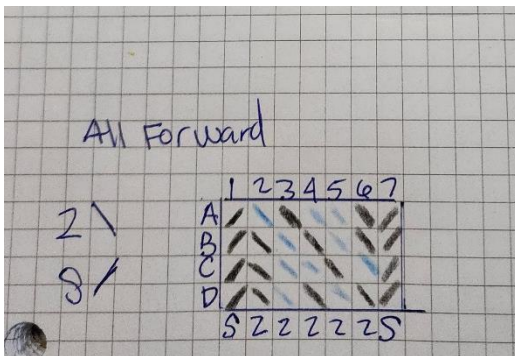
Card 2 has 1 yellow and 3 blue, etc.

The S & Z or \ / represents the side of the card you run the string through. There is a picture later that illustrates.



Now sometimes you'll want to write down your pattern like this especially if you do not have access to a printer.



Reading the rest of the pattern is a whole different lesson. Feel free to reach out to me if you're needing help with this. The whole S & Z or \ & / can be hard to decipher and totally will make your pattern not work right if warped incorrectly.

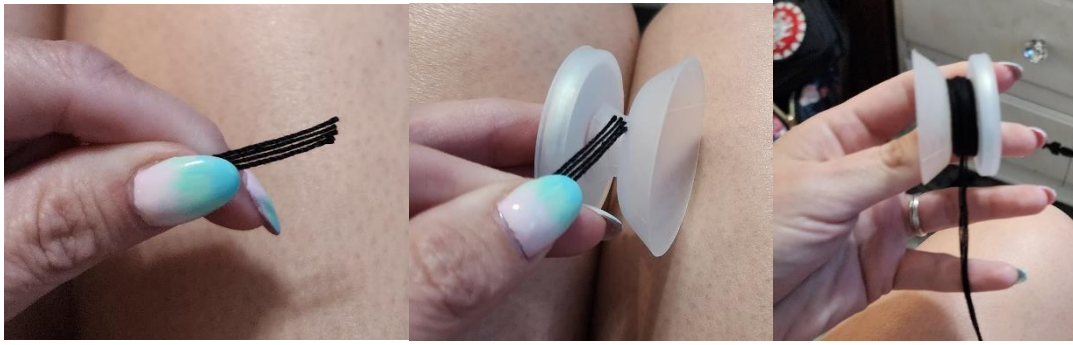
Once you have your pattern, you'll decide how long you'd like your project and pick out the thread you'd like to use. I always add 20% to my total length to give room for anchoring the project at the start and making a sample piece.

I usually use size 10 crochet cotton but you can weave with any type of string you'd like to.

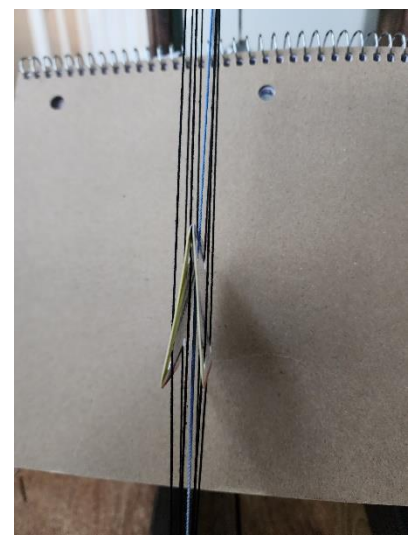


When I warp my loom [above], I use a 12 inch ruler to measure out my string. I like this method because I can be lazy and sit on my couch. Plus, it's super easy. I warp per card, so I'll do all 4 for that card. I've already determined how much warp I need so I'll divide that number by 12. So, if I need 12 feet, I'll wrap it around my ruler 6 times since you have 2 sides.

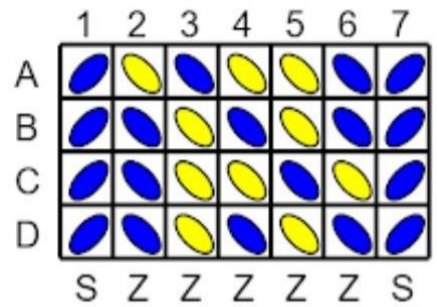
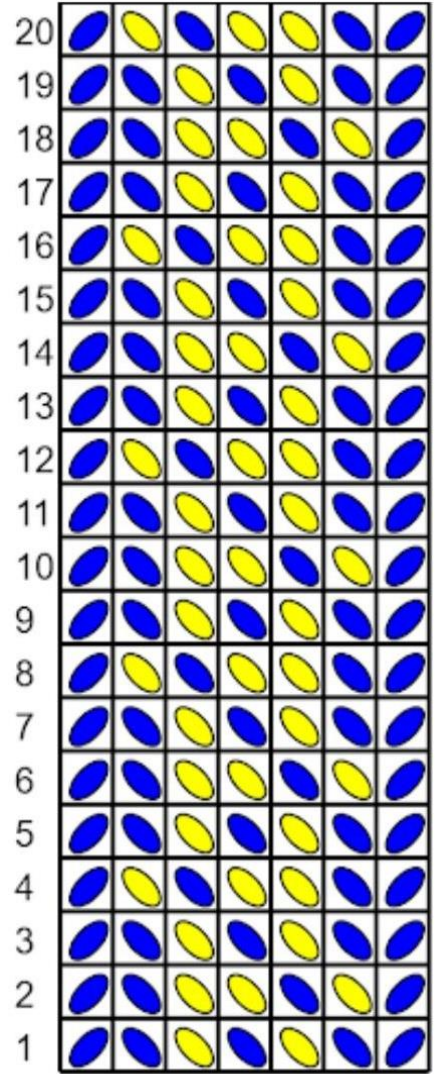
Once I have all 4 for that card measured out, I get them all together and wrap them around my bobbin (or nut if you do not have the bobbin). I like to number my bobbins so I can get them all loaded then I'll put them on my loom. Once I have all 4 for that card measured out, I get them all together and wrap them together around my bobbin (or nut). I like to number my bobbins so I can get them all loaded then I'll put them on my loom with the card.



In the pictures above you'll see how I use the nut with my bobbin set up then I'll warp my card according to the diagram. The last picture is the difference between S&Z or \ or /.

The finished product of the pattern is a variation of a band found in the Osberg shipwreck. That is my wrapping process. If you would like to learn how to card weave, please don't hesitate to reach out to me. I'd love to teach you!

There were so many memories of him that I had, words of advice that he shared & the Pelican/protégé relationship that we developed. So, I went out to the Baronial Facebook page to find what memories that he left to others. It was amazing the memories that everyone had. Anywhere from a single memory such as the booming voice he had to everything about him. It was just amazing. I hope that the rest of the story here will let those of us who remember him will bring a smile to your face & for others to know a man whose life was about friendship, mentorship, & service.

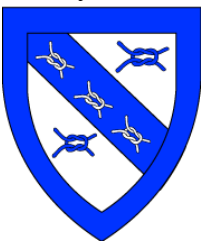


Master Yehuda was a tall man, a large man whose voice could carry across rooms, fields, & any place that he needed to get your attention. One of the things he loved to do was to shout “protégé” from across the room, or perhaps it was him shouting to his young daughter “Rebecca, get out of the dirt”. He carried a large staff with a teddy bear strapped on the top of that staff and he carried that staff everywhere.

He was about service, always coming to the aid of someone, arriving early to help set up an event. He would stay late to help clean up after the event. He was the Baronial Herald for many years & worked security for Estrella War. Master Yehuda worked many hours for security & would fall asleep on the cart because of the hours he put in for war. Once I needed to talk to him as my peer, so there we were sitting at 2:00 am on the cart & I was talking to him. I then asked a question & the answer he gave was a snore. Ah, but fear not, for the radio called for him & he jumped awake, & we took off.

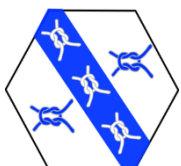
A memory that I want to share was perhaps one that he cherished. The King was looking for him in court, & Master Yehuda was outside talking to others. When he was informed that the King needed him, he did not hesitate & marched in & as he was walking towards the King stated loudly “you bellowed your majesty”. The King requested him to come forth & read a scroll for him and Master Yehuda did not question why he had to read the scroll, he just walked up on the stage & took the scroll. He was in service to the crown & to the Kingdom of Atenveldt. He started to read the scroll & it was an Award of Arms to his daughter. After choking up a bit in his voice he continued. There were many cheers & many happy tears watching him read his daughter award. He didn’t read the scroll because it was his daughter, he did it in service. He would have read a scroll to anyone, booming his voice across the masses and would stand there tall and proud for whoever was receiving the award.

One day, one quiet & sad day, Master Yehuda of Nuremberg, Larry Baum passed over the rainbow bridge to join others that passed before him. He was our seneschal at the time, & the barony grieved for him. Master Yehuda left us memories & leadership, a sense of service & a love for the SCA. He left for his protégés a sense of duty & a need to do service selflessly & brought many of us closer to each other. The barony knew that we had to move on, to continue the dream and many answer the call, not questioning but asking “What can I do”, “how can I help” & that sense is what he taught us about service.

"In AS 37 (2002) during the reign of Aaron & Alisandra I under the stewardship of Tatiana & Dmitri, Baroness & Baron of SunDragon there was created an award known as the Commander of the Honor of SunDragon. Amendments to this charter were made in AS 53 (2019) during the reign of Morgan & Elizabeth III, under the stewardship of Jacqueline & Gefroi, to remember the extraordinary service of Yehuda of Nuremburg, OP, a member of the Barony of SunDragon.

There shall exist in the Barony of SunDragon an award known as the Commander of the Honor of SunDragon. It may be given by the Baron or Baroness to full Companions of the Honor of SunDragon who have demonstrated high merit & continued service and duty within the Barony of SunDragon.

In remembrance of the extraordinary service of departed SCA populace member, Master Yehuda of Nuremburg, OP, the insignia of the commander shall consist of a golden hexagon shaped medallion depicting the blazon 'Argent, on a bend between two reef knots fesswise azure, three reef knots argent, a bordure azure' and shall be worn on the left shoulder." 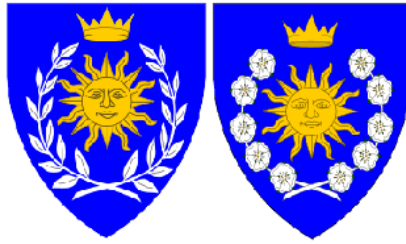

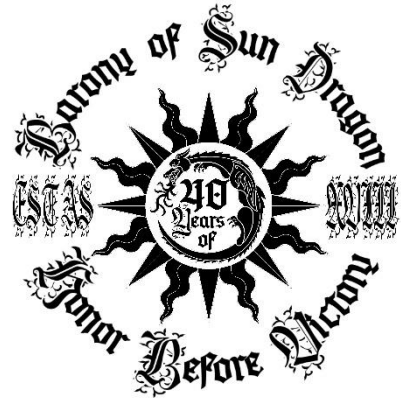
