There shall exist in the Barony of Sun Dragon an award known as the Order of the Prisma Draconis which shall be given by the Coronet to those who continue to give years of faithful service to the barony. This award may be given at any Barony of Sun Dragon event.



Honor of Sun Dragon

There shall exist in the Barony of Sundragon an award known as the Honor of Sundragon. It may be given by the Baron/ess to those people who have toiled in service to the Barony, or otherwise have excelled in merit. The holder of this award shall be entitled to place after their names C.H.S.D and shall be styled Companions of the Honor of Sundragon.

There shall exist in the Barony of Sundragon an award known as the Order of the Dragon's Fury. It may be given by the Baron and/or Baroness to those people who have displayed excellence in the fighting arts, both in the use and the teaching of the Weapons of Society for Creative Anachronisms, Inc.



Commander of the Dragon's Fury

There shall exist in the Barony of Sundragon an award known as the Commander of the Dragon's Fury of Sundragon. It may be given by the Baron or Baroness to full Companions of the Dragon's Fury of Sundragon who have demonstrated high merit and continued activity

in fighting arts within the Barony of Sundragon.



Order of the Dragon's Scale



There shall exist in the Barony of Sundragon an award known as the Order of the Dragon's Scales. It may be given by the Baron/ess to those persons who have excelled in the Arts in the Barony of Sundragon. The holders of this Award shall be entitled to place after their name CDS; and shall be styled as Companions of the Order of the Dragon's Scales.



Commander of the Dragon's Scale

There shall exist in the Barony of Sundragon an award known as the Commander of the Dragon's Scale of Sundragon. It may be given by the Baron or Baroness to full Companions of the Dragon's Scale of Sundragon who have demonstrated high merit and continued activity in the area of the arts and sciences within the Barony of Sundragon.

Order of the Dragon's Heart

There shall exist in the Barony of Sundragon an award known as the Order of the Dragon's Heart. The Order of the Dragon's Heart may be given by the Coronet of Sundragon to individuals who have shown the worthy qualities of courtesy and courtly behavior with such consistency that they are recognized to be an example of gallantry to all.



Commander of the Dragon's Heart

There shall exist in the Barony of Sundragon an award known as the Commander of the Dragon's Heart of Sundragon which shall be given by the Baron or Baroness to full Companions of the Dragon's Heart of Sundragon who continue to show the qualities of courtesy and courtly

behavior with such consistency that they should be recognized as an example of gallantry to all.



Order of the Rainbow's Promise

There shall exist in the Barony of Sundragon an award known as the Order of the Rainbow's Promise. The Order of the Rainbow's Promise may be given by the Coronet of Sundragon to individuals under sixteen years of age who are a radiant example of the promise of the Dreame by their efforts in the many aspects of the Society, which may include

arts, service, the fighting arts, and who display a good knowledge of the courtly graces.

Baroness's Cavaliers

There shall exist, in the Barony of Sundragon, an order known as the Order of the Baroness' Cavaliers which may be given at the pleasure of the Baroness to members of the populace of Sundragon who have demonstrated all of the following qualities:

- A. Exceptional skill and chivalry in combat with the weapons of the duello. Duello shall be taken to refer to rapier combat.
- B. Knowledge of the Courtly Graces, such as music, dance and other gentle arts.
- C. Obedience to the laws of the Society for Creative Anachronism, the Kingdom of Atenveldt, and the Barony of Sundragon.
- D. Consistent, courteous and noble behavior.

- E. Authenticity in dress, equipment and behavior, in keeping with their chosen "Persona".
- F. Show a willingness to share their knowledge and skills with others.

There shall exist in the Barony of SunDragon an award known, subject to approval by the College of Arms, as the Order of the Dragon's Talons, for Youth Combatants, which may be given by the Baroness and the Baron to individuals who demonstrate skill, enthusiasm and responsibility in the fighting arts and understanding the codes of chivalry.

The Barony of SunDragon is soliciting applications for the following positions:

Exchequer



The **Baronial Exchequer** is like the treasurer for our local chapter of the SCA. The Baronial Exchequer is the financial administrator for the Barony. They are responsible for tracking and reporting spending and income. This office requires attendance at baronial events (e.g., Mixed Weapons War, Fabric War, Champions, and Solstice) or kingdom events hosted by the barony (e.g., coronation) in order to manage the gate.

General requirements for this position:

- be a current paid member of the SCA in good standing, & must remain so for the length of the warrant (a minimum of 2 years).
- have a computer capable of running Excel & Word.
- have experience using Excel, including familiarity with formulas & working in large workbooks.

- have dependable access to the internet, the ability to regularly check & respond to email, the ability to send & receive emailed reports & attachments, & the ability to communicate with other SCA Officers using email & mail groups.
- have knowledge of, or willingness to learn (fast), double entry accounting on a "cash" basis.
- be familiar with Society & Kingdom Financial Policies & the administration of SCA financial guidelines.
- be willing to be a signer on all bank accounts in the Kingdom (your SSN may be required as part of the information given to banking institution), review bank statements for numerous Kingdom/Baronial Accounts & reconcile bank accounts for the Kingdom/Barony.
- manage & track SCA warranting, reporting, & compliance with SCA financial guidelines by Exchequers & Regalia Officers throughout the Kingdom.
- be willing to be responsible to the Society for all assets held by the Barony.
- create & manage a budget for the Barony of SunDragon & serve as a Chairperson or member on several financial committees.

This position requires regular communication between Society officers, Kingdom of Atenveldt officers, & officers in local groups throughout the Kingdom. Must be available to work with & manage Exchequer Deputies for the barony & manage & coordinate running of the front gate for Baronial & some Kingdom events hosted by the Barony of SunDragon.

Social Media Officer Listing

Mistress Emelyn Katrin Fraser - Member of the Order of the Pelican

What type of peerage are you a part of?

I am a Pelican.

How long have you been a peer?

I was elevated on July 20,2019 so, almost 5 years.

Who was your biggest mentor prior to being invited to your peer group?

Oh there were so many, but I would have to say my biggest would be Dasha, Sir Nudd and my own peer, Nichelle Whitewolf.

What was the biggest lesson you learned from them?

Biggest lesson, and it's going to sound silly, but really, "It's okay to say No" Also, "If it's no longer fun, stop doing it. Do not let it ruin your experience or make you bitter and end up ruining someone else's experience."

How has being a peer evolved the game or dream of the SCA for you?

Being able to help someone on their path has been the biggest thing. I traveled a lot as the Baroness of Atenveldt and got to meet a lot of people, but nothing compares to that impact of someone asking you for guidance as a peer. It really did just open the next chapter of the dream for me.

What has been your biggest struggle or learning point in your peerage?

The fact that you can't please everyone all the time. No matter how

hard you try. And being okay with saying no when someone asks for my help and I know my plate is full. It's hard not to feel guilty. That's my biggest struggle.

What future goals do you have for your continued participation in the SCA?

To continue having fun, because if it isn't fun, there's no point in doing it!

Describe what went through your mind when you were offered to join your peerage?

"I'm not ready! I could give a list of people who are/were more suited for peerage! I am just doing what I like to do in the dream!" I actually may have even said it outloud.

What advice do you have for those aspiring toward a peerage?

Don't ever do something you are not comfortable with and be the person you needed when you were younger. Don't get over committed and make sure you can follow through with the promises you have made to others. Never stop having fun!

What advice do you have for newcomers?

Most would say don't try and do everything at once. And although that's good advice, had I taken it I wouldn't be here. I dove in head first myself, but don't have too much pride not to ask questions. But bottom line, have fun!

In your perspective, what qualities do you look for in someone when contemplating them for your peerage?

Their body of work is always one of the things I look at but the biggest, how do they handle themselves while underpressure? How do they treat others in that time and in general. Someone can have an amazing body of work but pop their tops soon as pressure arises and that isn't good for anyone. How do they react publicly when someone else is offered? Basically how someone handles themselves and others is a big deal for me.

What is the most impactful lesson you have learned since becoming a peer?

When they say you words way heavy, they mean it. If you thought others were watching you before while you were on the path, the fish bowl just got deeper and those before me are wiser for it. Even as a peer it's okay to seek out others for advice and you should.
